ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students must meet the following eligibility:

- be at least 18 years old
- have an above average overall GPA (equivalent to 4.5 on ACU's 7.0 scale)
- Postgraduate students must have successfully completed the equivalent of an Australian Bachelors Degree
- English language proficiency (equivalent to IELTS 6.0 for undergraduate students or 6.5 for postgraduate students.

EXCHANGE NOMINATIONS

ACU will contact to confirm nominations and then send application guidelines directly to nominated students (and cc partner institution).

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

To apply, students must submit the following documents:

- · Copy of official academic transcript
- Copy of personal information page of passport
- English proficiency results (if applicable)
- · Personal statement

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Students are required to submit applications by the deadlines below and allow time to obtain a student visa.

Semester 1 (February to June): apply by 15 November

Semester 2 (July to November): apply by 15 May



APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Check you meet ACU entry requirements.
- 2. Choose an ACU campus and units to study.
- Submit an application online. Exchange students must request nomination from their home university.
- **4. Accept and pay.** Study abroad students required to pay tuition fees.
- 5. Apply for student visa.
- 6. Prepare for your studies.

STUDY OPTIONS AT ACU

Students have the flexibility to enrol in units from various study areas across ACU's four faculties. Whether they're fulfilling core requirements or exploring electives, they can choose the units that are right for them.

Study level: Undergraduate and postgraduate

Language of instruction: English

Unit requirements: prerequisite requirements (if applicable) must be met prior to enrolment.

Restricted study areas: Midwifery, Occupational Therapy, Paramedicine, Speech Pathology and Psychology (postgraduate).

ENROLLMENT AT ACU

Students must request, in their application, at least six ACU units to study at their preferred campus. The unit options will allow for availability and timetable changes.

A standard full-time study load is three to four units (30CP to 40CP). Typically 10CP at ACU is equivalent to 7.5 ECTS or 3-4 U.S. credits. Those who hold a student visa can only complete one 10CP course via online study.

ACU will process each students enrolment and provide an enrolment report, prior to Orientation.

STUDENT VISA

Students are required to hold a valid Australian visa for the duration of their studies and can apply once a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) is issued by ACU, at time of acceptance. Generally, study abroad and exchange students apply for a Student Visa (500) Non-Award. To explore visa options refer to the Department of Home Affairs.

ARRIVING AND LIVING IN AUSTRALIA

ACU hosts pre-arrival webinars to prepare students to study at ACU and also provides pre-arrival information at time of acceptance.

Cost of living: Depending on a students lifestyle and budget, cost of living will vary. This **cost of living calculator** is a great resource to help you prepare.

OSHC: Students are required to have Overseas Student Health Cover for the duration of their student visa. Evidence of health insurance is required for a student visa to be issued. Further information on health insurance can be found at: www.acu.edu.au/oshc

Airport pickup: Study Abroad and Exchange students are offered complimentary airport pickup when they arrive in Australia. Each student is required to submit an airport pickup request to receive an Uber voucher valued at AU\$75, valid for 6-months from date of issue. Further information will be provided at time of acceptance.

ACCOMMODATION

ACU offers off-campus housing, as well as exclusive offers with external student housing providers. Students will experience community living in an inclusive and supportive environment with students from Australia and the world.
